\*note creating & submitting a 3D Photo/Mixed Media Portfolio is encouraged

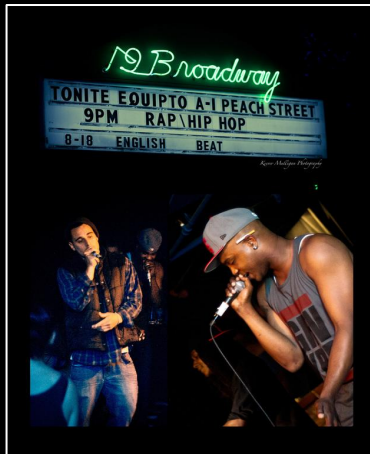

- Choose the AP 2D & Design or AP 3D exam (mixed media - including filmmaking), based on the content of your work
- Build a portfolio of work that shows your own expressive voice & creative intention
- Collaborate with a community of other dedicated art students - our family of artists!
- This project-based class is for the art student with a love of art & experimenting!
- Create an independent portfolio of work that reflects an in-depth personal investigation
